Amelia House, in York, is a purpose built five bedroom respite house that has been designed to enable individuals, families and carers to access out of home respite.

"Providing residential respite to the Wheatbelt community is one way we are able to support people. Senses Australia provides services to people of all ages, for all people with disability and we have done so for 120 years," says Carolyn.
